

10 WARNING SIGNS OF CANCER

IN DOGS & CATS

1. Persistent change in appetite and / or water intake
2. A lump that is enlarging, changing, or waxing and waning in size
3. Progressive weight loss or weight gain
4. Non-healing sore or infection, such as persistent nail bed infection
5. Abnormal odor
6. Persistent or recurring lameness
7. Chronic vomiting or diarrhea
8. Persistent or recurring cough
9. Unexplained bleeding or discharge
10. Difficulty swallowing, breathing, urinating, or defecating

EARLY DETECTION IS CRUCIAL FOR SUCCESS

Maintain a regular schedule of wellness exams with your family veterinarian. If you notice any of the above signs, call them for an appointment right away.
